WHAT IS A PROPERTY MAINTENANCE OPERATIVE?

The primary role of a Property Maintenance Operative is to optimise property condition and quality and to ensure the building is kept in a safe working condition.

Property Maintenance Operatives need to maintain a high level of quality, providing maximum satisfaction to customers, clients, guests, and teams with minimal disruption.

WHO IS THE APPRENTICESHIP AIMED AT?

Those working within a wide range of facilities roles, including:

Maintenance Assistant, Facilities Assistant, Maintenance Manager, Maintenance Technician, Caretaker, Multi-skilled Technician, Rental Property Services, Care Home Maintenance Staff and Academy Maintenance Teams. The list is endless.

DETAILS OF THE APPRENTICESHIP:

- The apprenticeship will typically take 24 months to complete including EPA.
- PMO workshop training will be practical hands on learning, based in Lincoln and on site.
- Apprentices will demonstrate core knowledge, skills and behaviours to be fully competent as a Property Maintenance Operative.
